Report on the Audit of Financial Statements

Opinion

We have audited the accompanying statement of quarterly and year to date financial results of Ankur Marketing Limited (the "Company") for the quarter ended 31st March 2021 and for the year ended 31st March 2021 ("Statement"), attached herewith, being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended (the "Listing Regulations").
